

It doesn't matter what kind of claim your making, the resolution of your claim could take weeks, months or even years. To be sure, you can ask advice from an [insurance adjuster](#) . Commercial claims on buildings and cars are often complicated. Homeowners and life insurance are less complicated, but involves the unprepared claimant settling with an insurance company that is well – experienced in rejecting claims.

Small issues like car damage or accident should be taken care of quickly. Working days are maybe too long to settle this case, same as medical claims, though it may take several weeks or maybe a month if the case is complex. Life insurance also should settle within weeks or month of processing the documents prior to the accident.

Business and home insurance are different, if you have business disruption insurance with the same insurer that covers your grounds; you may be able to make them do their job faster as everyday they don't pay you is another day they pay on the other policy. Anyway, in both business and home settlement will take a little longer than other policies, mostly if the damage was caused by a natural catastrophe that caused problems somewhere else as well. If you capture photos of the whole thing yourself, you may able to make the process much quicker, if it takes several days for the claims adjuster to make it out to your place, you should capture those pictures yourself anyway to document how much damage was caused.
